3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Speeding Traffic

Since the last meeting the location had been assessed and the road did not score highly compared to other sites, and records show that there had been one personal injury accident recorded at the location within the last 5 years.

With regards to the request for new signs to be erected the Department for Transport has issued guidance on reducing the amount of clutter on the highway network, therefore they are trying to minimise the number of new signs that are installed which will also assist in reducing maintenance costs.

The County Council has no legal powers to take enforcement action against drivers who exceed the speed limit. A Speed complaint form which can be completed and returned to Leicestershire Police Force HQ had been forwarded to the Chairman.

Fly Tipping
