- 3. Playing of live/recorded music on a Sunday 11am 6pm
- 4. Playing of live/recorded music on a Friday/Saturday 11:am 1:30am
- 5. For events over 1,000 people, conditions outlined in Annex 2 still applies

Reason:

The Sub – Committee having listened to all of the representations were satisfied that the 4 Licensing Objectives would be met and adhered to.
