3. **APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE AT KIRBY SELECT, 1-2 CHERRY TREE COURT, KIRBY MUXLOE, LEICESTERSHIRE LE9 2LQ**

Considered – Report of the Licensing Team Leader.

The Licensing Team Leader presented the report.

The Applicant put forward their case for a new Premises Licence.

DECISION

That the application for a Premises Licence relating to Kirby Select Ltd, 1-2 Cherry Tree Court, Kirby Muxloe Leicestershire LE9 2LQ be granted subject to the conditions set out below:

1. To permit the hours available to supply alcohol for consumption off the premises, and the hours the premises are to be open to the public to be between 07:00 to 21:00 hours every day.
2. The Premises Licence Holder will adopt a 'Challenge 25' Policy and provide adequate, documented training for staff before they are allowed to sell alcohol.
3. The Premises Licence Holder will ensure that internal and external CCTV is installed and operate an effective CCTV system which is to be maintained in good working order at all times the premises are open.

Reasons:

1. The hours be set at 07:00 to 21:00 due to the store being located in a residential area and also to satisfy the Prevention of Public Nuisance.
2. The 'Challenge 25' Policy satisfies the objective relating to the Protection of Children from Harm.

3. The installation of CCTV satisfies the objectives relating to Public Safety and the Prevention of Public Nuisance.
