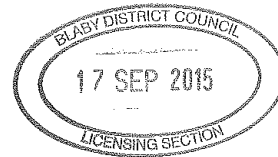

Hello

I live at Uppingham; Station Road in Elmesthorpe which is almost opposite Badgers Mount Hotel.

My husband and I are extremely concerned by an application by the new owners of the hotel to extend both the sale of alcohol and regulated entertainment until midnight on every night of the week.

This presumably means that cars will be departing until at least 1230 and quite possibly much later; and this could become a nightly occurrence which we consider to be totally unacceptable in a predominantly residential area.

It is also likely to be extremely noisy until very late if the entertainment is being held outside – with music being allowed to play until midnight.

To summarise we strongly oppose the application; we consider 1130pm on Friday and Saturday to be more reasonable; this would ensure that cars depart hopefully by midnight or not much after; it would also protect residents from disturbance during the working week – when 1030pm seems more than adequate.
