<p>ANNEX 1 – MANDATORY CONDITIONS</p> <p>No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -</p> <p>a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or</p> <p>b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.</p> <p>Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.</p> <p>(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.</p> <p>(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.</p> <p>(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either -</p> <p>(a) a holographic mark, or</p> <p>(b) an ultraviolet feature</p> <p>Minimum Drinks Pricing</p> <p>1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.</p> <p>2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1</p> <p>(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979</p> <p>(b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula</p> $P = D + (D \times V)$ <p>Where</p> <p>(i) P is the permitted price,</p> <p>(ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and</p> <p>(iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;</p> <p>(c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -</p>

- (i) the holder of the premises licence
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply under such a licence;
 - (d) "Relevant person" means in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
 - (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994
3. Where the permitted price given by paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

ANNEX 2 – CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

The current procedures and policies, including risk assessments, training of staff in all aspects of regulatory compliance and operating policies and measures for the avoidance of noise or other nuisance to neighbours will continue to apply.

The precise location of alcohol within the store will change from time to time; its location will always be subject to "responsible retailing".

A CCTV system will be maintained and fully operational throughout the hours that the premises are open for any licensable activities. The system will incorporate a recording facility and any recording will be retained and stored in a suitable manner for a reasonable period of time. The precise position of the cameras may be agreed with the Police from time to time.

A fire risk assessment is in place.

All food waste is bagged and tied and waste collection receptacles (skips/bins) are kept locked. Collections of refuse are made at appropriate intervals.

The licence holder is a signatory to the Portman Group Code of Practice on Naming, Packaging and Promotion of alcoholic drinks. Staff trained to request photographic proof of age (passport, driving licence, PASS proof of age card) from any person seeking to buy alcohol and appearing to the member of staff to be under the age of 18. The licence holder actively supports a Proof of Age Scheme. Age prompts on the tills alert a cashier when age restricted products are scanned. Signage advising staff and customers of ages for restricted products are displayed prominently in the store.

ANNEX 3 – CONDITIONS ATTACHED AFTER A HEARING

That all items identified by the computer system as alcohol will require the authorisation at that time and point of sale by a second employee (age-related sales trained) of the Company.
