To prevent crime and disorder	The purchasing of alcohol during the night could lead to/ fear of an increase in damage to property and cars owned by local residents -
Public safety	Currently there is an issue with cars racing the dual carriageway in Blaby - if there is an availablity to refuel all night this will encourage them to continue racing and this could jeopardise public safety and necessitate further police call outs
To prevent public nuisance	There is already an issue in Blaby necessitating in increasing Police presence at the local public houses fueled by alcohol - we feel havin a 24hr alcohol sale license would move the problem into the resident area after the 'pubs' have shut causing a public nuisance to resident and a further increase in Police call outs
To protect children from harm	We do not know the impact of noise opening 24 hours and this could impact on the sleep quality of residents children - sleep deprivation could impact on their health as could the witness of anti social behaviour from people congregating at the premises during hight opening
Please suggest any conditions that could be added to the	Since taking over from the Coop, they have left the forecourt lo

that could be added to the licence to remedy your representation or other suggestions you would like the Licensing Sub Committee to take into account.

Since taking over from the Coop, they have left the forecourt lights on 24 hours, We have spoken to them on numerous occasions as this is sleep disturbing and have reported it to a local Parish Councillor - they have ignored our requests

There was previously an application for 24 hour opening which was declinded by BDC - this is still the same residential area and it should be declined again
