Licensing Act 2003 (Hearing) Regulations 2005 – Section 28 and 29
Nags Head, Enderby, Leicester

I refer to your application for a Premises Licence for the Nags Head Public House, Enderby, Leicester.

At the hearing that was held on 27th September 2005, the Licensing Authority agreed to grant a licence subject to the following amendment and condition, in addition to the conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

- a) Amendment to the operating schedule and additional condition:
- Amplified music not to be audible beyond the curtilage of the premises.

You may appeal against this decision by writing to the Chief Executive to the Magistrates at Hinckley Magistrates Court, The Courthouse, Upper Bond Street, Hinckley, Leicestershire, LE10 1NZ within 21 days of the date of this letter. The court may:-

- a) dismiss the appeal
b) substitute any other decision which could have been made by the Licensing Authority, or
c) return the case to the Licensing Authority to dispose of it in accordance with the direction of the court

and may order costs as the court thinks fit.
